Guidelines for an Art Opening Reception

The reception will have to be **in the Library** and not in the Gallery area. Your work, of course, will be hanging in the gallery but no tables or chairs may be placed in the gallery. This is an opportunity for you to sell more of your work in addition to what is hanging in the Gallery. This is also an opportunity for people to be introduced to our Library.

- The artists will incur all costs of the reception; this includes food, beverages, flowers and linens.
- The Library will provide the facility, tables, music and someone to work the front desk and a policeman if you serve alcohol.
- The event is to be no longer than 2 hours.
- Receptions are to be done the first Friday of the month from 5:30-7:30 p.m. This should be done the first month your display goes up, ie January, March, May, July, September, November.
- If putting out your own publicity the name of our gallery is: The Library Gallery at Birmingham Botanical Gardens. Also the name of our library is: The Library at Birmingham Botanical Gardens. Please use it correctly.
- If you do not have a following in the Birmingham area please consider carefully whether you want to go to the expense of having a reception. We can send out invitations to 100 people and only get 3 responses. The bulk of people who come will be largely based on your following.
